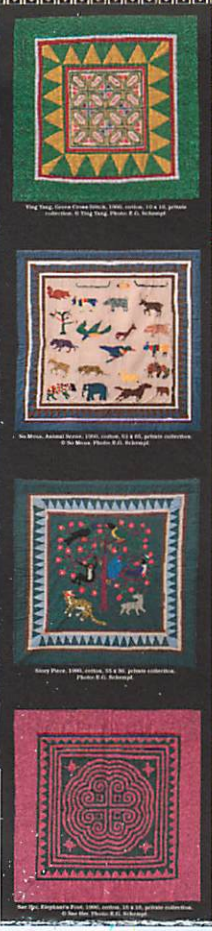
## Cloth As Community: Hmong Textiles In America

Hmong flower cloth (or *paj ntaub*) is one of the world's great textile traditions and an excellent example of cloth as community. The works illustrate the profound relevance of textiles as infrastructure in the Hmong culture, an art form that shifted as it adapted to fit new realities. The exhibition features over two dozen textiles—flower cloths and embroidered story clothes—by those in the Hmong community.

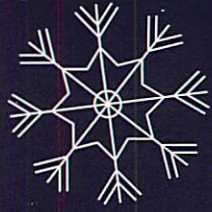
